CLIFF CAVIN IS ARTIST OF THE MONTH AT MUSEUM OF WESTERN ART

The Museum of Western Art will host artist Cliff Cavin for the month of November. A wine and cheese reception will be held with Cavin as guest speaker on Thursday, November 16th, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. The event is free and open to the public with a suggested donation of \$10. Museum members attend at no charge.

Cavin, a native of San Antonio, is a landscape artist who has been painting for over 35 years. His focus is on the views of the American West, especially Texas and New Mexico. He has participated in shows such as the C.M. Russell Invitational Sale and Benefit, the American Plains Artist Museum Show, and the Oil Painters of America National Exhibition. He has also had exhibitions at the Southwest School of Art and at the San Antonio Art League. This is the 12th year that Cavin has been invited to participate in the annual Briscoe Western Art Museum Night of Artists Sale and Exhibition. His paintings have won numerous awards and are collected both nationally and internationally in private and corporate collections, including Valero Oil, M.D. Anderson Hospital, Jefferson State Bank, Baylor Scott & White Health, and Cibolo Creek Ranch.
