Cowgirl Peg is actually Peggy Sunberg, who has been writing award-winning children's books since 2002. Her newest book, "The Adventures and Mis-Adventures of Cowgirl Peg," is a result of many students' requests for a chapter book. As with each of the previous books, this one includes life messages that will positively impress readers. In addition, the story instills a curiosity about our country's Western heritage, and about kindness and compassion towards animals and people. Illustrator Pat Wiles has partnered with Peg on each of her books with beautiful watercolor artwork, including both the cover and inner sketches of the new one. Readers with a 4th grade reading level and higher will enjoy this book, which retails for \$9.95.

Cowgirl Peg will be accompanied to the museum by her dog Harley. In addition, Destinee Rendon of Grey Ranch Training Academy will bring her German Shepherd Ty, who is a therapy dog. Stephanie Turnham, Executive Director, said, "Since all of Cowgirl Peg's books have animals in them, we thought it would be fun to have some well-behaved canines here."
